

N.E.A.S.A.A - 2A Girls Volleyball Zone Championships - Hosted by Ecole Notre Dame High School

Venue: Ecole Notre Dame High School & Dr. Bernard Brosseau Middle School

Dates: Friday, November 15th and Saturday, November 16th

Entry Fees: \$325.00/team payable to N.E.A.S.A.A. (All entry fees must be paid at the championship to avoid a potential fine). NDHS will collect and deliver to the NEASAA Treasurer.

Eligibility: All 9 Registered 2A Girls Teams from the North East Zone are eligible to compete.

Rules: The rules of Volleyball Canada shall govern all N.E.A.S.A.A. Volleyball Championships.

Modifications:

1. Substitutions – The modified 12-substitute rule will be used.

a) A team shall be allowed a maximum of 12 substitutions in any one game

b) A player may leave the game and re-enter the game, but only for the same player. Players are 'tied' together e.g., 7 for 12 – these two players are attached for that game, and a player must re-enter for the same player

c) Unlimited substitutions are allowed up to 12 per game Examples: i. 7 for 12; 12 for 7 (2 subs) x 6 = 12 subs

ii. 7 for 12; 12 for 7 (2 subs) x 2 = 4 subs +

8 for 6; 6 for 8 (2 subs) x 4 = 8 subs

12 subs 2. Allow teams to list up to 15 on roster. 3. Uniforms: NEASAA is not adopting the FIVB uniform rule.

Format:

- All matches are best of three; rally point – first two games to 25 (must win by at least two points) and if third game is required to 15 points (must win by at least two points).
- There are No Cap's in any games.
- The top three teams in each pool advance to playoffs – the first place teams receive a bye to the semi-final and the 2nd and 3rd place teams crossover and play in the quarter-final (see draw attached).

Tie-Breaking Procedure: As outlined in the NEASAA Handbook...If two or more teams are tied at the end of the preliminary round the following criteria will be applied, in order:

- A. The team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering only matches between the tied teams will be ranked higher.
- B. The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering only matches played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
- C. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering only games played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
- D. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering all games played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
- E. Any game needed to break ties will be a single game, rally point scoring to 25 points with a two point difference to determine placing.

Officials:

- Officials will be assigned by our Zone Official's Coordinator.
- It is our commitment to have trained scorekeepers and lines judges provided for each game throughout the tournament...we will do our best to do so; however, teams **may** have to provide if we

fall short of qualified volunteers.

Seeding for all Zone Volleyball Championships shall be established by the respective ranking officers using the guidelines established in the NEASAA Constitution (Page 40)

Coaches & Officials Room:

- Coach and Officials room will be located in the staff room at ENDHS.

Other Information:

- Please make your players and spectators aware of the following information:
- ASAA Spectator Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced.
- Please keep all food and non-water drinks out of the gymnasium.
- Please help us keep our school clean by wiping wet/soiled shoes thoroughly and placing garbage/recycling in bins provided.
